## *A message from the Rabbi*

*Shalom*, dear members and friends of Temple Beth David,

First and foremost, a big Thank You to all that came and participated in the commemoration of the four Chaplains Sunday the 20th of February. The fact that so many of you came was overwhelming! The outreach and comradeship to our non-Jewish brothers and sisters demonstrated the very same act of courage and valor of the Four Chaplains we all came to hold high in our hearts.

Following up with my address to you in the previous Newsletter, I want to encourage you to take a more active role in services, classes, and offerings. Doing so will enhance the sense of ownership by the community in that particular service and will increase the bond of all members to each other and the congregation at large.

Here are some concrete suggestions that could be used to stimulate your thoughts in that realm:

Sign up to read the Haftarah translation: when doing so, please pick up those verses within the haftarah that resonate for you, regardless of the portion that will be chanted in Hebrew.

Celebrate a Simḥa by offering to do a portion of a service: it may be a birthday (your own perhaps or of someone you love and want to send your blessings to), an anniversary, birth of a grandchild, Bar/Bat-Mitzvah, and whatever it is that you wish to celebrate. You might ask: What portion of the service? To which I would answer, anything! It can be any part from our Siddur, a poem that you feel is appropriate, a short story. Or sign up to do an Aliya on Friday or Shabbat Services.

And on the opposite side of the spectrum, commemorate the passing of a loved one in an equivalent way – in addition to saying Kaddish. Reciting a Poem prior to the Kaddish itself is a very moving and meaningful way to enhance your own and the congregation's connection with the soul we remember.

Each and every one of you is an expert in something, an expertise and a story that may be exciting to others and worthwhile to share. Teach a class as an Adult Education offering. You will be surprised by the interest people will show in your story and wisdom and the good feeling it will instill in you after doing so.

As I have said to you in my previous message, I am here for you and available to respond. My door is (almost always) open. I encourage you to come and talk with me. Share with me your experience with services and classes, critic the way I do things, give suggestions to improve, and recommendations for additional activities and offerings. I truly welcome your inputs and am not taking offense from any criticism; on the contrary: I appreciate the direct and honest exchange of thoughts. After all, that is the only way I can learn and improve.

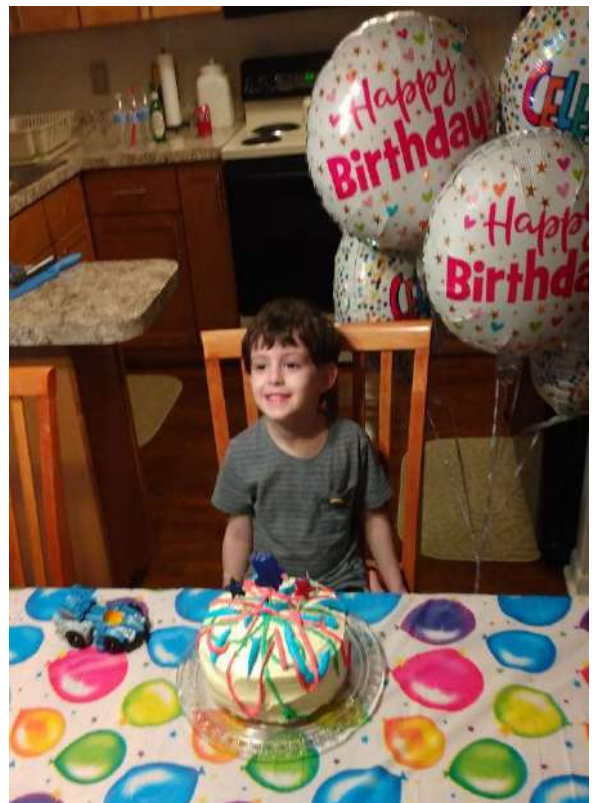

Information on the situation in Ukraine, and what is in planning for the Ukrainian Jewry by European congregations.

By your editor.

As being a Swedish citizen, and living in Stockholm, Sweden, as well as being a member of the unity congregation in Stockholm, I wanted to inform you what I received, from our president, just a few days ago, since it could be of interest for you.

**“Dated February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

**Due to the war in Ukraine, the Stockholm Jewish Congregation notes the there is a great commitment to want to help, not at least all the organizations that are now raising money.**

**The Jewish congregation does the following:**

**We have a close dialogue with other Jewish congregations and organizations in Europe and Israel, as well as with representatives of the Jews in Ukraine in order to be updated on what is happening on the ground in Ukraine and in what way we can assist based on defined needs.**

**We have established contact with Swedish authorities and are structuring and preparing for a situation where we may need to receive Jewish refugees or assist in other ways.**

**We are following developments very closely and will return shortly with information on how the Stockholm Jewish Congregation is acting regarding the war in Ukraine, and in what way we may need help from your members.**

**Dear members,**

**Let me start by thanking everyone for the great commitment you show.**

**We will already now allow members to register an interest in helping. In this newsletter and on the parish's website, all members will be given the opportunity to log in and fill out a contact form. If you have the opportunity to help in any way - feel free to sign up now and the congregation will come back if the need should arise and what help will be needed.**



**Having said that, I would like to emphasize that the war in Ukraine is not a crisis for us Jewish congregations. It is the authorities who primarily have to deal with the refugee issue by allowing them to enter the country (the Swedish Migration Board) and to provide the refugees with housing and necessities (MSB). Our contact with these authorities is to inform that the Jewish congregations have a special competence when it comes to Jews who come here and that we are available.**

**The war is directed at the whole of Ukraine and not specifically at Jews. This is important information and the Jews of Ukraine fear that if there are too loudly targeted efforts for only the Jews, they risk that anti-Semitic events will be the consequence.**

**We are and will continue to be proactive as soon as we receive information that Ukrainian refugees have arrived or are on their way to Sweden.**

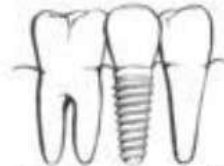
