

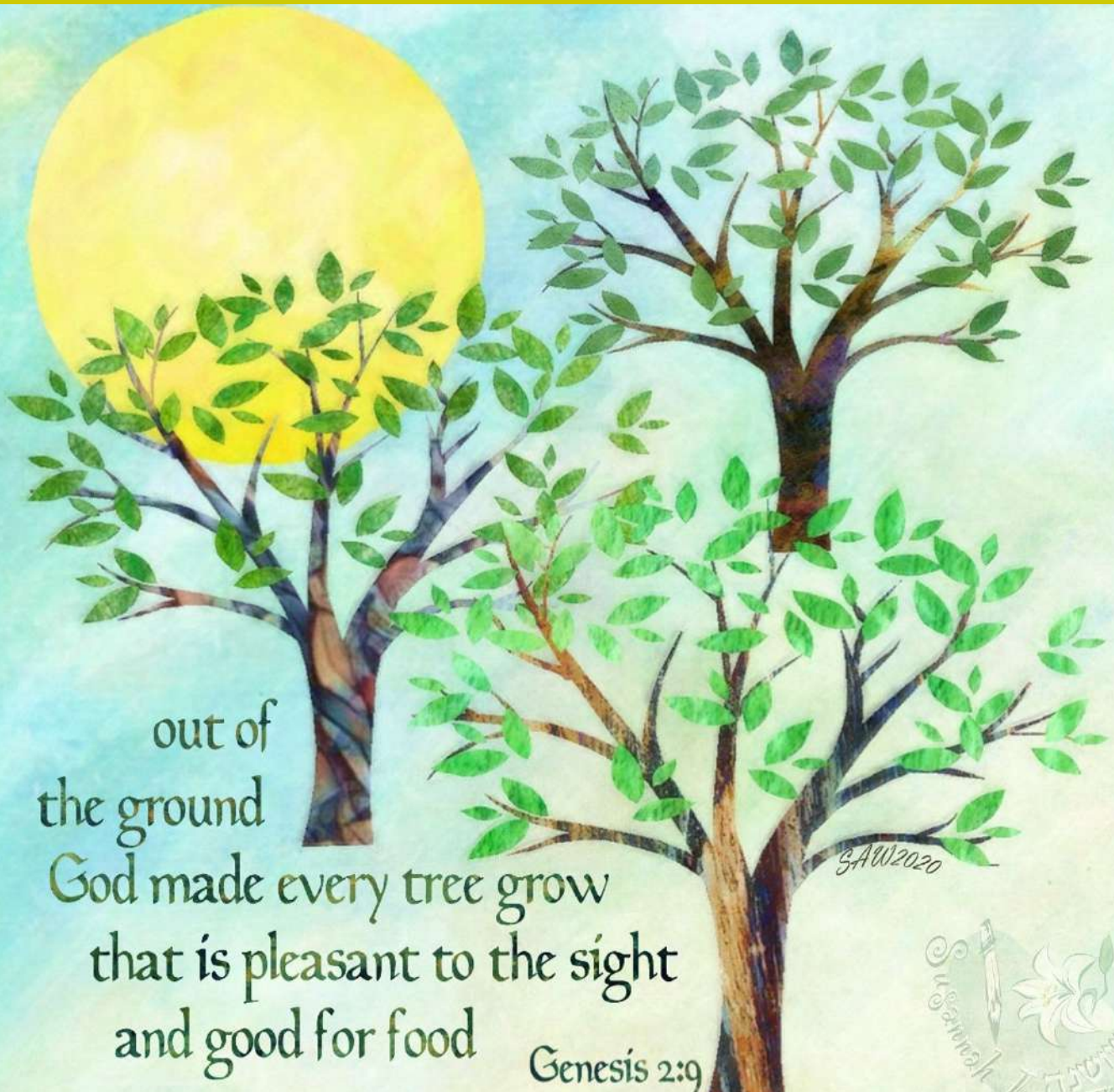

## A personal presentation by Rabbi Ben-David

I was born in Israel to Arie, a Hungarian Orthodox Rabbi who made Aliya to Eretz Israel in 1925 and Naomi, a Holocaust survivor, coming to Israel from Hungary in 1949. My involvement in Israel's defense started at age of thirteen when I entered the Maritime High School, which was also attached to the Naval Academy. The Navy then sent me to the Technion, a highly regarded Engineering and Science University, only to immediately upon receiving my Mechanical Engineering degree, enroll me as an Officer. During my five years in active service and later for an additional 15+ years in the Navy Reserves I worked on weapons systems and was responsible for the highest-level maintenance of fire-control computers and radars, optical directors, missiles, and hydraulics. Becoming an authority and in charge of equipment and the lives of those who use the equipment in your early 20's is not uncommon in Israel.



At the age of 27, after finishing my active duty and becoming a Reservist, I joined Rafael Advanced Defense Systems, which at that time was part of the Ministry of Defense. I started at the lowest rung as a mechanical engineer, working on some amazing technologies such as infrared night vision systems. In 1985 the Israeli Navy ordered new periscopes for its submarines from a company called Kollmorgen in Massachusetts, requiring them to integrate Rafael's infrared subsystem into the periscope. I became the program manager responsible for everything from initial design to manufacturing, delivery and support of the infrared subsystem. The Contracts Manager at Kollmorgen was Connie, later to become my wife, and that is how we got to know each other.

Over the course of roughly four years, through multiple design reviews and as the program developed, Connie and I were in constant communication and our mutual families became friends. We visited each other, and even after the program was over, we stayed in contact. A good example of our friendship was demonstrated at the time of the first Gulf War, during which time I was in Milu-eem – Reserves Service. When the first rocket attacks hit us from Iraq and my family was closed in a sealed room, to protect them from chemicals that might be in the warhead of those missiles, Connie called us from the States. "It's dangerous! Send your kids to us!"

Later on, I had the privilege and joy to work on some of the most exciting defense projects in Israel, arguably in the world. One of them is the Litening Targeting Pod, known in the US jargon as AN/AAQ-28. The technologies and knowledge that was developed in this program was migrated to other products and solutions that served in defending Israel, the US, and many other international allies, around the world.

### cont'd: A personal presentation by Rabbi Ben David

It was in 1999, that I reconnected with Connie. She suffered multiple traumas in a short period of time, including the loss of her husband. Her rabbi and her boss at United Technologies arranged for her to take a six-month sabbatical in Israel so she could study at Hebrew Union College and regroup. It was only natural for me to help her find an apartment and get acclimated. At that time, my wife and I were separated and in the process of getting divorced.

One thing led to another, and instead of going back to the US after the sabbatical leave, Connie moved in with me and we have been together ever since.



After retiring from our work at Rafael in 2014, we moved to Ashland OR. My vocation that led me throughout my entire life – defending Israel – took a different form. I started to engage with Jewish congregations, supporting them in following their spiritual, ritual, educational and communal paths, while being inclusive, accepting of diversity, and fostering the love of Israel. In parallel, realizing my thirst to deepen and widen my knowledge base in everything to do with Judaism, I embarked on Rabbinical studies, receiving my ordination as a Rabbi in 2018. Shortly thereafter, Rabbi David Zaslow of Havurah Shir Hadash and I published the Siddur Lecha Dodi for Kabbalat Shabbat, which is a tool that supports congregations who seek a new spiritual connection to the Shabbat tradition.

I enjoy very much teaching, and the spectrum of subjects I enjoy talking about is quite broad: Torah, Jewish thought and law (Halakha), “Judaism 101” and of course – all about Israel: history, current affairs, technology, and deepening the understanding of the Arab/Palestinian – Israeli conflict. I strongly believe that learning together is also a great avenue to interfaith activity and forging our connections with the larger community, as well as attracting our unaffiliated sisters and brothers to be engaged with our activities as a Jewish Community Center.

After all, in my humble opinion, Judaism is not a religion per-se. It is a People, that share, among many other things, religion. A Jewish person is a member of the People regardless of adherence to ritual and halakha. The message that I’d convey to the non-affiliated Jews and to the members of the congregation alike is that there are so many different ways to experience and express one’s Jewish Identity: study, culture, acts of loving-kindness, Tikkun Olam and being immersed in the daily life of the community. I am excited and looking forward to working together with the vast number of volunteers of the community, to offer a wide variety of activities that would attract and draw more Jews that would, as a result of these activities, desire to become members of Temple Beth David and deepen the relationships of Temple Beth David with the larger community of Spring Hill and beyond.

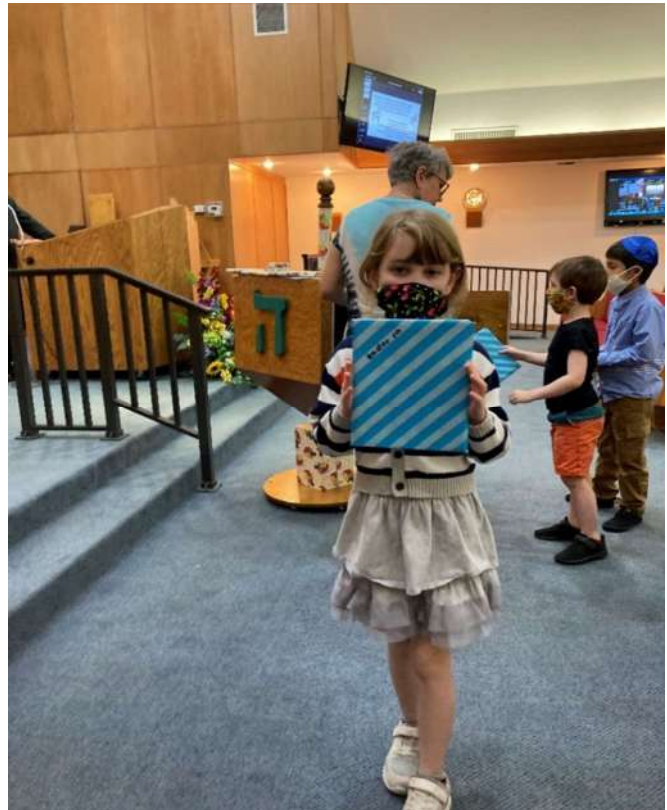

### **Larry Jasper To Achieve 125 Gallon Donor Milestone**

#### **Career As A Blood Donor Began After Army Retirement**

(Spring Hill, FL: December 26, 2021) At his upcoming platelet donation, Larry Jasper will join the ranks of less than 50 Floridians who have reached the 125 Gallon Donor milestone, since blood banking began during the Second World War! He has helped to save or sustain many hundreds of lives and families!

After 30 years of service in the Army, most of them in Special Forces, Larry retired in 1997. In 1999, Larry became a whole blood donor in New Jersey and soon after that, they asked him to donate platelets. Larry moved to Florida in 2004 and continued to donate platelets regularly. Larry was the first donor to donate when OneBlood opened their new Donor Center in Spring Hill earlier this year and now will achieve his next donor milestone. He plans to keep giving as long as he can because he knows there is a need for it.

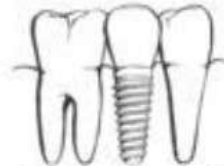
